





It features a strategically located trigger button, allowing for activation by the index finger without moving the hand from the mask. And, with a simple 180° turn, its Universal Resuscitation Mask can fit a small child as well as an adult, perfectly.

keeping your patients alive and breathing

The Porter O-TWO's demand valve function delivers 100% oxygen to a spontaneously breathing patient with minimal respiratory effort. The oxygen demand flow is controlled by the patient's inspiratory effort, with flow rates up to 160 lpm to accommodate his/her tidal volume demand. When used with patients showing signs of breathing distress, the delivery of pure oxygen will help keep the patient fully oxygenated, minimizing the onset of hypoxia and apnea.



- Unique quick-connect compatibility assures immediate access to all Porter oxygen equipment in your office.
- Manual Ventilation Flow Rate of 40 lpm meets the American Heart Association recommendations.
- Ergonomically placed Manual Ventilation Button helps ensure a tight mask seal by enabling both hands to remain on the mask during ventilation.
